PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, clean, safe water is essential to the health, safety, and quality of life of our residents, businesses, wildlife, and natural environment; and

WHEREAS, the United States Congress enacted the Clean Water Act of 1972 and the Safe Drinking Water Act of 1974 to protect the nation's water resources, safeguard public health, and preserve clean drinking water for current and future generations; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency recognizes August as National Water Quality Month to encourage communities to raise awareness about the importance of protecting and conserving our water resources through education, stewardship, and responsible environmental practices; and

WHEREAS, the City of Palm Coast remains committed to providing safe, reliable drinking water and protecting the environment through the operation of three water treatment plants and two wastewater treatment plants, while continuing to invest in critical infrastructure that supports the community's future; and

WHEREAS, protecting water quality is a shared responsibility, and every resident, business, school, and community partner plays an important role by conserving water, properly disposing of household chemicals, reducing pollution, and helping preserve our waterways for generations to come.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Palm Coast, Florida, that the month of August 2026, be officially designated:

WATER QUALITY MONTH

encourage all residents to recognize the importance of clean water, practice responsible stewardship of our natural resources, and support ongoing efforts to protect and enhance the quality of Palm Coast's water for the benefit of our community today and for generations to come.
